The Heart to Heart Hospice Inpatient Center has seven beautifully appointed private suites that open out to a peaceful garden area. Each room will have its own decor, private bathroom, TV, sitting area for family, and accommodations for one overnight guest. The common areas include a family room, quiet room, children’s playroom, and a full kitchen and dining area for friends and family members to gather.

A tentative Open House is scheduled for October, with details to be announced soon.
